## KOLKATA & HAORA STREET MAP



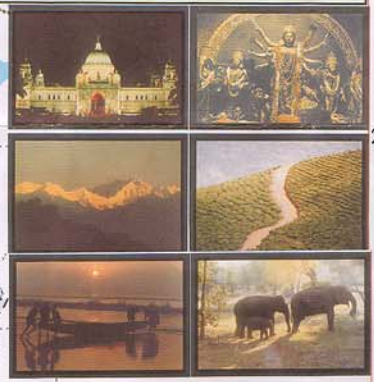

Sunderban is the world's largest Mangrove forest and the habitat of famous Bengal Tigris. A few picturesque beaches like Digpal and Sarkisong are famous for casino plantations and fish culture are located at Southern part of the state. Kolkata, the capital of the state, once the country capital of undivided British India is still the cultural capital of the country and proudly the centre of attraction for famous Durga Puja Festival and innumerable historic and heritage sites and architectural marvels like Victoria Memorial, Shahid Minar St. Paul's Cathedral, Belur Math.
